What is a direct cremation?

A direct cremation is a simple and respectful alternative to a traditional funeral, without a formal service at the crematorium. It allows everything to be taken care of professionally, while giving your family the time and freedom to remember you in a way that feels right to them.

When the time comes, we bring your loved one into our care and look after them with dignity at every stage. The cremation takes place privately at one of our trusted crematoria, without mourners present. Throughout the process, we keep your family updated every step of the way, so they always know what is happening and when.

We also let your family know the date and time of the cremation, giving them the opportunity to pause, reflect, or do something meaningful at that moment, wherever they may be.

After the cremation, the ashes are returned to your family or scattered in the crematorium's garden of remembrance, depending on your wishes. For every service we carry out, we also donate to plant a tree in memory, creating a lasting tribute.

From there, your family are free to plan a personal send-off in their own time, whether that's a quiet gathering, a celebration of life, or something completely unique.

For many people, a direct cremation offers a simpler, more flexible approach that focuses on what really matters, while avoiding the cost and formality of a traditional funeral.



How does it work?



Contact

Our friendly in-house customer service team are here to help even if you just have a question. Having a funeral plan in place means that when the time comes, it is very straightforward for the person making the arrangements.



Collection

We can collect from anywhere in mainland Britain. Urgent collections from a private residence, nursing home or hospice are available 24/7. Everything is carried out with the utmost dignity and respect.



Cremation

Including the crematorium fees, removal of a pacemaker and a simple coffin of any size. We also provide a cotton gown if required. An unattended cremation will take place at our chosen crematorium.



Ashes

Returned in a biodegradable urn to a loved one within mainland Great Britain at a convenient time. Or the ashes can be scattered at the crematorium's garden of remembrance.

Traditional funeral V Direct cremation

Why more people are choosing a simpler funeral

Traditional funerals have followed largely the same format for generations. A service is held at a religious venue or crematorium, organised and led by a funeral director, often accompanied by the familiar symbols of the profession, the cane, the black hat and the formal procession, with the entire ceremony usually condensed into less than an hour.

For many families today, this Victorian-era tradition no longer reflects how they wish to say goodbye. The pressure to organise a formal ceremony quickly, alongside the rising cost of traditional funerals, can make the experience feel stressful at an already difficult time.

A direct cremation offers a different approach. By separating the cremation from any memorial or celebration of life, families have the freedom to remember their loved one in a way that feels personal and meaningful to them. Whether that is a quiet gathering, a memorial held later, or a celebration in a place that was special to them, the choice is theirs. With traditional funerals now costing thousands of pounds more, it is no surprise that many people are choosing this simpler and more flexible alternative.

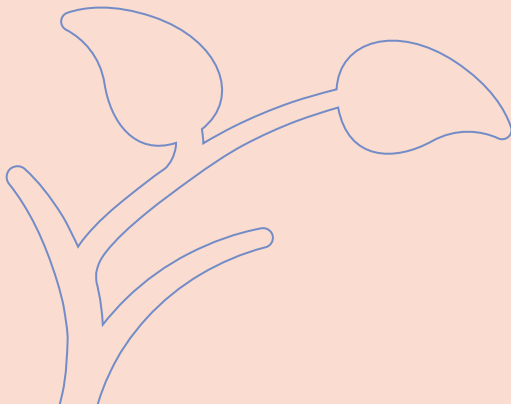

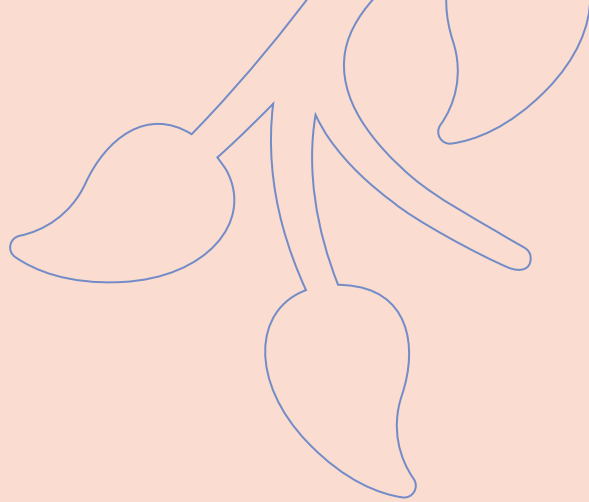
Is a direct cremation right for you?

A direct cremation may be the right choice if:

- You prefer a simple and dignified farewell, without the formality of a traditional funeral service.
- You would rather have a more personal celebration of life at a time and place that feels meaningful.
- You want to keep funeral costs more affordable, while still ensuring everything is handled professionally.
- You value a more flexible approach, rather than following traditions that may no longer feel relevant.
- You would like to remove the pressure on your family to organise a funeral quickly.
- You do not feel that a formal service at the crematorium reflects your wishes.

What is a prepaid funeral plan?

A prepaid funeral plan allows you to purchase the funeral you want in advance, ready for when you need us in the future. This could be a funeral you want for yourself, or maybe you're planning ahead for a loved one.

Did you know?

A funeral director cannot hold money for someone's funeral longer than 28 days if the person is still alive, unless it is set up as a funeral plan in accordance with the law. So if you want to pay for your funeral in advance, the only legal way to do so is with a prepaid funeral plan.

Funeral plans are now regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority

What does this mean?

Extra protection for monthly instalment plans

If you take out a monthly instalment plan with us, as long as you keep payments up to date, you'll be completely covered after 2 years if you pass away, even if you haven't finished your instalment plan.


Also, you will be covered for accidental death straight away. This means that if you die as a result of an accident, your funeral is still covered even if you haven't finished paying for your plan.

Financial Ombudsman Service

If you have a complaint that has not been resolved by us, you can refer the issue to the Financial Ombudsman Service giving you a second line of protection. The FOS can resolve disputes fairly and impartially and has the power to put things right.

Financial Services Compensation Scheme

All funeral plans are protected by the FSCS, so if we go out of business and are unable to pay you the money you're owed in accordance with their rules, then you will be able to claim compensation to cover any financial loss you incurred.



Is a prepaid funeral plan right for you?

If you feel that the funeral may need to take place soon, you should check what the price of the funeral is if you needed it straight away, as you will usually need to spend slightly more to buy a prepaid funeral plan to cover the cost of setting it up. Though it's important to bear in mind that the price of a funeral without a plan is subject to increase without notice.

If you think you may need the funeral soon and would rather wait, simply give the person likely to make the arrangements our details so they can call us direct at the time of need. However, if you would prefer to pay in advance or secure a price that's fixed and guaranteed,

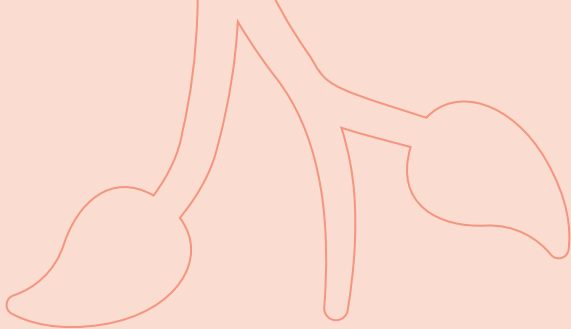

What is included in our prepaid direct cremation plan?

What is not included in a direct cremation?

A direct cremation means there is no service at the crematorium, so there are certain things that are never included.

- The use of a hearse or limousine
- Flowers, tributes or memorials (family are free to send us items to place in the coffin)
- A ceremony at the crematorium
- Choice of crematorium or cremation date and time (we do let the family know the date and time of the cremation)
- Mourners attending the committal

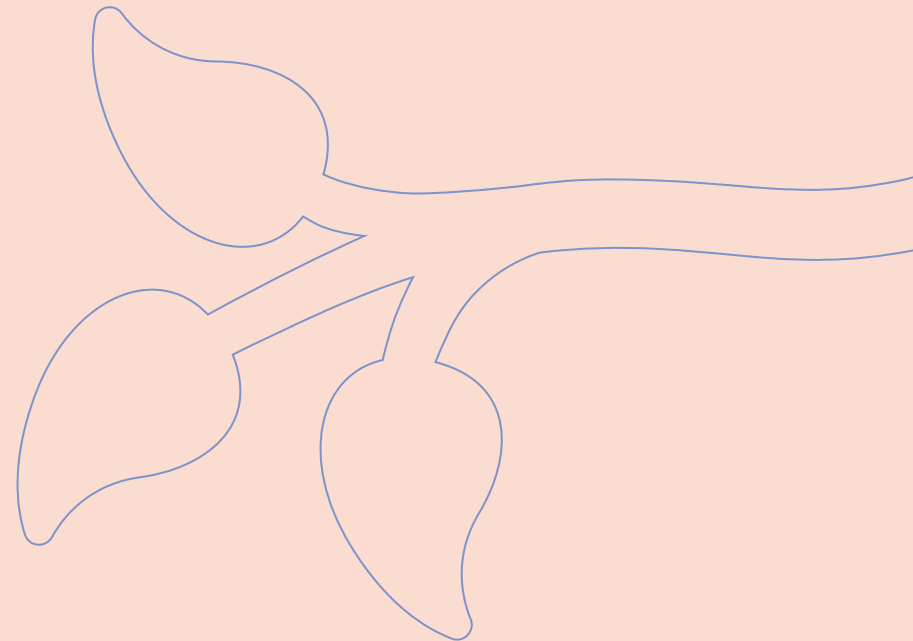

Pay in full

There is no age restriction if you would like to pay in full.

There is no upper age limit on plans up to 2 years. Instalments are made by monthly direct debit.

Important information about your plan

Instalment plans between 1 and 5 years include an instalment charge of 4% of the total cost per year to help keep up with inflation.

If you choose an instalment plan, you can pay a deposit, pay your plan off or switch instalment plans any time - simply give us a call.

There is a 30 day cooling-off period from the date of order. After this time, subject to the Terms and Conditions, a £99 cancellation fee will apply.

Your plan is at risk if you do not keep up with regular payments.

Pay by instalment up to 5 years

The person who the plan is for must be 80 or younger by the time the below plan terms finish.

Frequently asked questions

Can I setup a joint plan?

Our plan is even more flexible than this. Once a plan is paid for it can be transferred to anyone. So if you have a plan with us and a loved one of yours passed away, you could use your plan for them instead.

What is the coffin made from?

Our simple, traditional coffins are made from chipboard and MDF which use responsibly and sustainably sourced materials, including recycled rather than solid wood where possible.

Is the crematorium local to me?

Our partner crematorium may not be local to you, as a direct cremation means there is no service at the crematorium. However, you are still able to organise for the ashes to be scattered or interred locally. We also let the family know the date and time of cremation so that they can do something special at the time.

Where am I covered?

Our plan covers you across all of mainland Great Britain, excluding the Scottish Highlands and any islands not connected by a bridge. It is possible for us to access these areas but there might be an additional charge at the time of need.

What happens if you go out of business?

Your money is paid into a secure trust which is completely separate from our business. In the unlikely event that we cease trading, a suitable replacement provider will take over the funeral plan contracts. If that is not possible then you will be refunded an amount equivalent to purchase a replacement plan on terms corresponding to this one. Your plan is additionally protected up to £85,000 by the FSCS (Financial Services Compensation Scheme) to ensure you do not suffer any financial loss.

What if I change my mind?

We give you a 30 day full money back guarantee. That means if you change your mind within 30 days of ordering your plan, you will be refunded in full. Cancellation after this time will result in a refund of all monies paid less our cancellation fee of £99.

Are there any age restrictions?

You must be over 18 to purchase our prepaid plan. There is no upper age limit if you decide to pay for our direct cremation plan in full or by monthly instalment up to a period of 2 years. If you wish to pay by monthly instalment over a period longer than 2 years, such as our 3, 4 or 5 year plan, then the person who the plan is for must be 80 or younger by the time the instalment plan finishes.



What if I donate my body to medical science?

We fully support organ donation and the like.

There are usually 3 possible outcomes:

- 1.** The medical school or hospital accepting your donation may arrange and pay for your remains to be cremated and the ashes returned to family.
In this instance, we would be happy to refund your plan in full to your estate, with no cancellation fee.
- 2.** The accepting organisation may insist you have a funeral director in place to cremate your remains after the donation process.
Here, your plan with us would still be needed and we would simply collect from them and complete the direct cremation as planned.
- 3.** The institution may not be able to accept your donation at the time for various reasons.
In this scenario, your plan with us can proceed as set up.

What happens next?

1

Order a plan with us by phone, post or via our website.

2

We will ask who the plan is for and ideally take details of a next of kin.

3

We can record up to 4 next of kin and send each of them a copy of the plan documents if you wish.
